Retasting from bottle many of the top grands and premiers crus from this warm, much-vaunted vintage, close Burgundy observers were pleasantly surprised not so much by the exceptional quality as by the preponderance of fresh, well-balanced, well-proportioned wines, reports Neil Beckett. CHABLIS PREMIERS CRUS

Chablis Vaurent - 89

Chablis Montée de Tonnerre - 89.6

Pale lemon. Appropriate aromatic austerity and restraint, with light mineral-smoky reduction, but intriguing rather than offputting. Dense, rich, and ripe on the palate, with a beguiling silky texture, but all the exhilarating intensity and vitality one would wish: already harmonious and thrilling, but still very much on the rise.

CHABLIS GRANDS CRUS

Chablis Les Clos - 87.9

Chablis Bougros, Côte Bouguerots - 90.7

Pale lemon-gold. There is good lemony intensity under the light butterscotch on the nose. Broad and dense on the palate, the phenolic richness adding definition and another dimension. Still nascent, but should gradually come into even sharper focus.

THE WORLD OF FINE WINE 100-POINT SYSTEM	
50-74	Disagreeable or faulty wine
75-79	Sound but dull or boring wine of no character or appeal
80-84	Enjoyable, simple, and straightforward wine
85-88	Good wine, but with no outstanding features
89-92	Very good wine, with some outstanding features
93-96	Outstanding wine of great beauty and articulation
97-100	Great wine of spellbinding beauty and resonance, leaving the drinker with a sense of wonder
